The following were elected to serve as general committee members, with one becoming membership secretary


Alan Sellar Ian Brown Roy Craig

CAIRNGORM DEVELOPMENT...

Cairngorm Mountain is planning a Mountain bike activity area in the lower Ciste side of the ski area. The idea is to use the refurbished Ciste chairlift to lift the riders and their bikes to mid-mountain using purpose built cradles at the side of each chair to carry the bikes uphill.

The diagram below shows that there may be three different downhill tracks available from (sort of!) easy to much more challenging. The thoughts on Winter Highland suggest that it has a chance of coming to fruition because the company would get nearly year—round income from both bikers and skiers. Let's hope the development gets the go-ahead.
